Important information:

Students' Result Check: The 1st term result has been uploaded. Check your wards academic and behavioural performances through the result. To ensure that those results are properly checked, each student must submit a photocopied document of the result to his form teacher. This must be done on Monday, 12th April, 2021. Failure to comply will prompt the management to send the child home.

The Children's Welfare: The days are unquestionably perilous. All eyes must be on these children, and all hands-on deck, too. Guard them enviously for their safety. Better still, encourage them to keep their minds and hands busy by carrying out their series of projects given to them. Those projects are part of their continuous assessment. This implies it must be properly done.

Still on this, it is advisable to take your child/ ward to hospitals for proper medical check-up and medications before resumption. Kindly check their uniforms and other materials they use in school. Many of the students lack the basic things they need in the school. It is not proper for us to send students back home due to some of these things. Kindly help us so that we can give the best to your children.

Completion of Outstanding Debts: This is to remind those that are still owing the school in any way to kindly pay up before the second half of the term. The modus operandi here in DBSS is that every child must be debt-free before he is allowed to write his examination. And if, by any way, the child misses any subject, he won't be given the opportunity to re-write it. Therefore, save your child from this loss of examination marks.

Kindly be reminded that on resumption for third term, all students are to pay the third term fees. Kindly prepare yourselves for this task ahead.

Students' Projects and Assignments: Students are given projects and assignments to carry out at home. Ensure that those assignments are properly done. Those assignments contribute immensely to their Continuous Assessment marks. So, support them especially on the financial areas
