Today, 23rd August, 2021, marks the official closing of DBSS for the 3rd term as well as the 2020/ 2021 academic session. So far, so good, it has been God all this while. It was a very successful inception and a wonderful conclusion, too. We thank Him immensely.

DBSS resumes for the new academic session of the 2021/2022 on the 13th September, 2021. Boarders return on Sunday, 12th, at or before 3. 00p.m. We have zero tolerance for lateness as defaulters will be severely sanctioned.

Important Information:

Dressing Code for resumption: All students are directed to put on the DBSS customized cultural attire on the resumption day on 13th September, 2021. Boarders should wear it to school on the 12th of September while all the students, both boarders and non-boarders will wear it to school on Monday, 13th. The material is sold at the cost of N1,000 per yard. Get your ward's own material at the school. On the resumption day, no students will be allowed inside the school premises without the cultural wear. At this juncture, too, you are reminded that all students must resume before 3.00pm. Late arrival attracts punishments and sanctions.

St. John Bosco Youth Centre Summer Holiday Camp: St John Bosco Youth Centre organizes a one-month activity-packed holiday for children and youths. The program features academic lessons for the primary pupils and secondary students, skill acquisitions- bead making, tailoring, shoe making, etc., treasure hunts, sports, liturgical services, and lots more. Avail your ward the opportunity to participate in this program. The program lasts from 4th August to 27th August, 2021. Application form is N100 and camp fee is N1,400. For those intending to stay in the hostel for the whole camp, fee is N25,000. For further enquiries visit the youth center.

Proper and Decent School Uniforms. We have talked about this matter over and over! Stop sewing the students' uniforms elsewhere! Buy only from the school. This minimizes the high rate of wrong colours and styles among the students. Moreover, check your child's/ ward's uniforms properly. Sew broken seams and hems, replace buttons, repair shoes and sandals, cut their hair, just normal low cut (no styles). Ensure total cleanliness of your child/ ward. Let them appear completely clean and decent. The virtue of cleanliness keeps them closer to godliness. Henceforth, we condone no scruffy appearance anymore.

Completion of the DBSS Project Levy and other Outstanding Debts: This is to remind those who have not paid the project levy, Fifteen Thousand Naira (N15,000), and those that are still owing the school in any way to kindly pay up before resumption.

Very importantly, fees should be paid before resumption as no child will be allowed near the DBSS entrance gate without a statement of complete payment. On this note, an official permission should be granted by the Director ONLY to those that could not meet up, and this must reach the office of the Director two weeks before resumption.

Submission of photocopy documents of the 2020/2021 Annual result to the school: all students should submit the photocopy of their annual result to their respective form teachers. This should be done on the official resumption day, 13th September, 2021. Failure to do this will prompt the school sending the child home.
